SOLUTION ATTENDANCE POLICY

ABSENCE / ATTENDANCE POLICY

At Nor*Cal Elite, we believe in the importance of consistent attendance to maintain the integrity and success of our teams. Therefore, we do not excuse absences from practices for any reason. Every absence, regardless of the reason, impacts the team equally. In order to ensure fairness and equal treatment for all families, we have implemented an attendance deduction system that applies to all NCE athletes.

SUMMER SEASON ABSENCES

(JUNE 1-AUGUST 14)

Athletes are allowed to miss a total of <u>4 PRACTICES</u> throughout the summer training months. Every absence that exceeds the 4 allotted will result result in a <u>\$40.00 PER PRACTICE</u> fee.

FALL SEASON ABSENCES

(AUGUST 15 - OCTOBER 30)

Teams will be learning and repping their choreography during these months.

PRACTICES 2 WEEKS PRIOR TO NCE SHOWCASE

(THIS INCLUDES ALL EXTENDED OR ADDED PRACTICES)

\$100 PER PRACTICE

ABSENCES WITH REQUEST NOTICE

(REQUIRED TO BE AT LEAST 14-DAYS PRIOR TO SCHEDULED ABSENCE)

\$30 PER PRACTICE

ABSENCES WITHOUT REQUEST NOTICE

(THIS <u>INCLUDES</u> REQUESTS SUBMITTED WITHIN THE 14-DAY WINDOW)

\$50 PER PRACTICE

COMPETITION SEASON ABSENCES

(NOVEMBER 1 - MAY 5)

Teams will be constantly detailing and upgrading their routines to best prepare for competitions.

(FEE WILL BE DEPENDENT ON THE EVENT AND COST TO REPLACE ATHLETE)

PRACTICES THE WEEK OF A COMPETITION

(INCLUDES ALL EXTENDED OR ADDED PRACTICES 7 DAYS PRIOR TO AN EVENT)

\$200 PER PRACTICE

PRACTICES WITHIN 2 WEEKS OF A COMPETITION

(INCLUDES ALL EXTENDED OR ADDED PRACTICES 14 DAYS PRIOR TO AN EVENT)

\$150 PER PRACTICE

ALL OTHER ABSENCES

(REQUEST FORM REQUIRED AT LEAST 14-DAYS PRIOR TO SCHEDULED ABSENCE)

\$70 PER PRACTICE

SPECIAL CIRCUMSTANCES

Serious illness, mandatory school absences, and extenuating circumstances will be taken into consideration, but may still result in the posted fee.

EXCESSIVE ABSENCES

Excessive absences (especially in the summer months) may result in an athlete being removed from their team, moved to another team, or potentially made an alternate without a refund.

COMPETITION ABSENCES

Any athlete who misses an event is subject to replacement. A fee will be assessed for the replacements participation in the event. Any athlete who misses an event will be put back into the routine at the coaches discretion, meaning there is no guarantee if/when an absent athlete will be put back into the routine.

Each team is assigned an arrival time to the venue and asked to check in with a designated NCE staff member at that time. Athletes and parents will receive an itinerary the week of competition describing exactly how and when to arrive to the venue; such as hair, make-up, apparel etc. When the athlete checks in, the "performance factors" (hair, make-up, uniform, etc.) are checked and approved by NCE staff.

The final schedule for each competition is made available to us the week of competition. We will provide an itinerary as soon as we receive the final schedule from the Event Producer.

Athletes should expect an all-star competition to be an **all-day commitment**, which can sometimes last until late in the evening. We expect our athletes to support <u>ALL</u> assigned Nor*Cal teams at <u>EVERY</u> competition until dismissed. Any reason that an athlete needs to leave early requires approval prior to competition day.

TRAVEL < OMPETITIONS

When our teams travel to competitions, they are typically two-day events, which take place on Saturday and Sunday. Prep competes 1 day.

Athletes may be required to arrive Friday evenings by 5:00 PM for practice at various events. Please be aware that award ceremonies can run quite late on Sunday evening.

Participating in All Star Cheerleading requires a significant financial commitment. it is important to carefully consider the investment involved.


AGREEMENT

STEP 2


RECEIVE AN EMAIL

You will receive an email outlining the next steps for your tryout.

STEP 3

RECEIVE YOUR TRYOUT APPT

You will receive an email with the date/time your tryout will be held. All tryout appointments will be scheduled May 13-19.



Arrive on the specified date of your tryout appointment at the location you registered at.

STEP 5

RECEIVE YOUR PROVISIONAL PLACEMENT

Provisional team placements will be sent no later that May 20th.
