WHAT WE'RE ABOUT

Our mission is to create an environment where the youth and teens in our community can learn, train, and grow as cheerleaders with positive encouragement, safe instruction, and overall fun experiences for athletes and parents. At Nor*Cal Elite, we care about every individual that walks through our front door. We are eager to share our love of the sport with girls and boys of all ages. This is our "train for life" commitment to you!

WHAT IS MIDSEASON?

Midseason teams consist of boys and girls ranging in age from 6-15 years old. Teams are separated into age groups or divisions that allow the athletes to compete against other teams of similar age and skill set. Skill sets define the level in which a team competes, these range from Novice to Level 2. Beginner levels are intended to give participants a well-rounded, basic cheerleading foundation. It is our goal to give our athletes the safest cheerleading experience possible in an atmosphere that is optimal for their skills, goals, work ethic, and maturity.

LEVELS/DIVISIONS

All our teams at Nor*Cal Elite adhere to the divisions regulated by the USASF - the governing body of All Star Cheerleading. This season, we anticipate offering teams for the following age groups and all will participate at competitions:

MINI NOVICE - This "level" is intended for entry level athletes and aims to focus on a fun and exciting introduction to All Star Cheer.

JUNIOR PREP 1.1 - The exact level/division for this age group will be determined after the first few practices.

JUNIOR PREP 2.2 - Level 2 assessments for this team will be held on September 21st from 3:00pm - 5:00pm. Athletes will be chosen for this team pending the assessment. Any athlete that does not make the Level 2.2 team will be given a placement on the Level 1.1 team.

PRACTICES / DATES

Our Midseason Teams will practice in 2-hour blocks on Sundays (1 per week) for the season. Practices will begin on Sunday, October 5th and run through April 19th, 2026.

ALL COMPETITIONS ARE MANDATORY TO ATTEND. ATHLETES WHO MAY MISS A COMPETITION WILL BE INELIGIBLE TO PARTICIPATE IN THE MIDSEASON PROGRAM. IF AN ATHLETE IS PLACED ON A TEAM & NOTICE OF INABILITY TO ATTEND A COMPETITION DURING THE SEASON IS GIVEN, A \$500 FEE OR BUYOUT FEE MAY BE ASSESSED.

ABSENCES

FINANCIAL AGREEMENT

This Financial Agreement ("Agreement") sets forth the financial obligations of athletes and families participating in Nor★Cal Elite's Midseason Program.

PAYMENT OF THE REGISTRATION FEE CONSTITUTES ACCEPTANCE OF THIS AGREEMENT AND HANDBOOK IN FULL.

FEES AND PAYMENTS

Athlete and family agree to pay all required fees as follows:

- Registration Fee – \$175 (due at Sign-up, non-refundable)
- USASF Membership Fee – \$49 (paid directly to USASF by October 31)
- Uniform – \$300–\$500 (due November)
- Competition Bow – \$30 (due November)
- Competition Shoes – \$120 (due October)
- Monthly Tuition – \$130, due on the 1st of each month (October–April)
- Team Fees – \$135, due on the 15th of each month (October–April), covering choreography, music, coaches' fees, competition entries, practice top, and gifts.
- Total Season *Estimate* – \$1,855 (not including registration/membership fees, travel, lodging, warm-ups, backpacks, or makeup).

All fees are non-refundable.

ABSENCES

Athletes are permitted two (2) absences per season. Each additional absence will incur a \$35 fee.

COMPETITION REQUIREMENT

Attendance at all scheduled competitions is mandatory:

- Nfinity Grand Prix – February 21, 2026 (Sacramento, CA)
- Encore Showdown – March 28, 2026 (Daly City, CA)
- The Celebration – April 25–26, 2026 (Sacramento, CA)

Failure to attend may result in a \$500 penalty fee per missed event.

WITHDRAWAL / BUYOUT POLICY

If an athlete withdraws from the team and/or program at any time:

- The remaining balance of all tuition and fees becomes immediately due in full; and
- A \$500 fee per scheduled competition will be assessed; and
- Any additional costs already incurred (uniforms, music, choreography, etc.) remain payable.
