We welcome athletes of all skill levels, from those with no experience to very high-level cheerleaders. You will have an opportunity to demonstrate your proficient skills to the NCE staff and then be placed accordingly on the team that best suits your proficient skill level and ability.

Teams are selected so that each have the best possible chance of a highly successful competitive season. After placements are complete, parents (or athletes) are contacted via email to let them know the team(s) they will call family for the season ahead.

PRACTICE ATTENDANCE POLICY

Nor*Cal Elite does not excuse absences from practices for any reason. All absences affect the team in the same way, regardless of the reason. To accommodate every family equally, Nor*Cal has created an attendence deduction system to be adhered to by all NCE athletes.

Please note: Serious illness, mandatory school absences, and extenuating circumstances will be taken in to consideration, but still may incur absence fees. Excessive absences may result in an athlete being moved to another team or potentially made an alternate without a refund.

COMPETITION ETIQUETTE

WHAT TO EXPECT

Each team is assigned an arrival time to the venue and asked to check in with a designated NCE staff member at that time. Athletes and parents will receive an itinerary the week of competition describing exactly how and when to arrive to the venue; such as hair, make-up, apparel etc. When the athlete checks in, the "performance factors" (hair, make-up, uniform, etc.) are checked and approved by NCE staff.

EVENT SCHEDULE

The final schedule for each competition is made available to us the week of competition. We will provide an itinerary as soon as we receive the final schedule from the Event Producer.

Athletes should expect an all-star competition to be an **all-day commitment**, which can sometimes last until late in the evening. We expect our athletes to support <u>ALL</u> Nor*Cal teams at <u>EVERY</u> competition until dismissed. Any reason that an athlete needs to leave early requires approval <u>prior</u> to competition day.

TRAVEL EVENTS

When our teams travel to competitions, they are typically two-day events which take place on Saturday and Sunday.

Athletes <u>may be required</u> to arrive Friday evenings by 5:00 PM at various events. When and if needed, teams practice on Friday evening and sometimes, time permitting, have team bonding activities following practice. Please be aware that award ceremonies can run quite late on Sunday evening.

Failure to follow directives for competition days may result in financial consequences for parents.

PAR<NTS/SP<<TATORS

Crowd participation is a **HUGE** factor in the teams performance and overall placement. Parents/Spectators are expected to cheer and chant to the best of their ability throughout the entirety of **ALL** NCE routines (not just your athlete's team).

It is expected that superior sportsmanship is exhibited towards all programs, teams, and staff members at every event.

NEXT STEPS

STEP 1 | GO TO NCEALLSTARS.COM

Complete the interest form and register for a tryout appointment or the season (two different links will be available).

STEP 2 | RECEIVE YOUR TRYOUT APPOINTMENT

An email will be sent with the day/time of your evaluation during our tryout week May 11-15th.

STEP 3 | ATTEND YOUR TRYOUT APPOINTMENT

This will be your tryout time at the location of your choice to be placed on a provisional team.

STEP 4 | RECEIVE YOUR PROVISIONAL PLACEMENT MAY 17TH

Your provisional team will be based off of your evaluation and can be adjusted prior to final rosters being set.

STEP 5 | REGISTRATION FEE DUE

If not already signed up, the Resgistration Fee will be due prior to your first practice. *ASK US ABOUT OUR SPECIAL DISCOUNTS*
